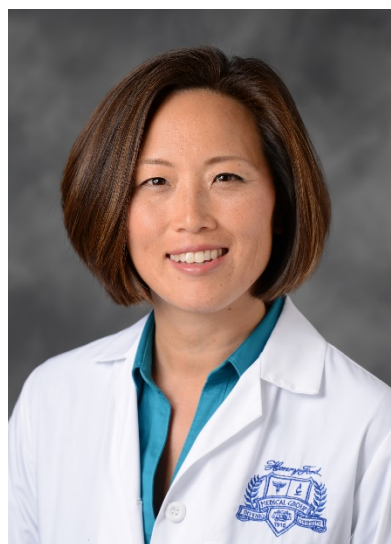


Betty Chu, M.D., MBA
