Jenine C. Parchmon is the Senior Vice President and director of the Technology Strategy, Planning and Innovation group at Comerica Bank. Ms. Parchmon is responsible for leading all key strategic initiatives across the Technology organization to ensure successful delivery and execution of the technology vision.
